HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION IN NC *Quantity over quality?*

KEY FACTS: • Between 2006 and 2009, North Carolina's graduation rate increased by 2.3 percent. At the same time, the community college remediation rate increased by 7 percent.

• Low academic standards and expectations are one of a number of factors that provide marginal students an easier path to graduation, thereby helping to increase North Carolina's graduation rate.

• Nearly two out of three high school graduates who subsequently enrolled in a community college needed to take remedial courses in English, reading, and/or mathematics before they were ready for college-level work. Significant percentages of students enrolled in remedial courses suggest that the standards for high school graduation remain alarmingly low.

north Carolina's high school graduation rate has increased from 68.3 percent in 2006 to 77.8 percent in 2011. While the graduation percentages are straightforward, the factors contributing to this increase are not.

Theories about the causes of the state's graduation rate increases abound. State education leaders credit dropout prevention programs and other state and local graduation efforts. Others contend that the dismal job market encourages potential dropouts to stay in school and obtain a high school diploma. Proponents of e-learning and online schooling argue that the North Carolina Virtual Public School allows struggling and at-risk students to individualize their learning environments, as well as recover course credits lost through absences or failed classes. Finally, some attribute the rising graduation rate to enrollment and demographic changes in school districts. These four issues — state and local programs, economic conditions, e-learning, and school district demographics — will be assessed in forthcoming studies of North Carolina's graduation rate.

This study will examine the quality of high school graduates by focusing on students who enroll in a North Carolina community college and take a re-

medial or so-called “Developmental” English, reading, and/or mathematics course[s] from 2007 to 2009.¹ Data from the NC Community College System (NCCCS) show that an increasing number of graduates from North Carolina public schools lack the basic skills needed to enroll in college-level courses required for their chosen program. Significant increases in English and mathematics remediation suggest that the standards for high school graduation remain alarmingly low. These low standards are one of a number of factors that provide marginal students an easier path to graduation, thereby helping to increase North Carolina’s graduation rate.

Unfortunately, remediation and graduation data are limited. Thus, the purpose of this study is to provide an overview of a complex issue that deserves greater attention from the educational research community. Researchers should conduct a comprehensive study of the relationship between graduation and remediation using multiple, multi-year student performance metrics. Additional studies should include an assessment of the costs of remediation, successful initiatives that decrease the remediation rate, and a closer examination of the quality of Developmental instruction at all post-secondary institutions.

Limitations of this study

This study is limited to students enrolled in an NC Community College System institution. It does not include students who are required to enroll in a remedial class at a four-year college or university. It also does not account for students who do not possess the requisite skills or knowledge to function in a workplace.

A focus on community college students is advantageous for several reasons. First, the NCCCS does an admirable job of maintaining data on student enrollment for all institutions in the state’s community college system. Second, North Carolina’s 58 community colleges are financially and geographically accessible to most of the state’s high school graduates. Finally, community colleges enroll students with a broad range of academic goals and interests — from career and technical education to eventual enrollment in a four-year college or university. In sum, community colleges provide a better representation of the “typical” North Carolina high school graduate than students who enroll in a traditional, four-year college or university.

Statewide Graduation Rates and Developmental Course Enrollment

According to the NC Department of Public Instruction, North Carolina’s four-year graduation rate increased by 2.3 percent — from 69.5 percent to 71.8 percent — between 2007 and 2009 (see Table 1).² The graduation rate formula tracks the number of students who begin ninth-grade and graduate four years later. This includes students who transferred into the state and does not include students who transferred out of the state or died. The U.S. Department of Education does not permit school districts or states to count GED students as high school graduates.³

As a percentage of the total graduating population, students who enroll in a Developmental class account for approximately 20 percent of all high school graduates in North Carolina.⁴ Of course, that does not include students who enroll in a remedial course in another institution of higher education, such as a four-year college, university, or trade school. Thus, the full proportion of high school graduates who do not possess the requisite English, reading, and mathematics ability likely exceeds 20 percent.

Between 2007 and 2009, the percentage of students who enrolled in one or more Developmental courses at an NC community college increased by seven percent (see Table 2). Between 2007 and 2009, an additional 2,400 students enrolled in remedial English. Developmental reading added over 1,300 students, and Developmental mathematics increase by over 2,400 students.⁵

During the 2009-10 school year, over one-half of students enrolled in a North Carolina community college took a remedial mathematics course. Nearly 40 percent of students enrolled in a remedial English course. In sum, 64 percent

of new community college students enrolled in one or more remedial courses, a 7 percent increase from the 2007-08 school year. (For school-level data, see the Appendix to this report.)

According to one NCCCS official, “Developmental education has been called a graveyard of dreams for many low-skilled students.”⁶ It is not difficult to see why. Of the thousands of students required to enroll in a Developmental English, reading, or mathematics course, an average of 20 percent of them do not earn a “C” or better.⁷ Pass rates for Developmental mathematics courses approached 75 percent. Fortunately, 2009 pass rates in these courses have remained at or below their 2007 levels.

Conclusion

During this year’s state budget debate, Chairman of the State Board of Education Bill Harrison contended, “North Carolina’s system of education is not broken. In fact, North Carolina’s system of education is a model for states across the country.”⁸ He pointed to “years of steady increases” in North Carolina’s graduation rate, including “the highest level ever recorded in 2009-10, at 74.2 percent.” On the surface, North Carolina’s increasing graduation rate appears to signal a systematic improvement in our public schools. But quantity is not the same as quality. As North Carolina’s

public school districts have continued to increase their graduation rate, they have done so at the expense of providing graduates with basic literacy and numeracy skills.

If taxpayers want North Carolina to be economically competitive, then they must not believe state education officials who call our public school system a model of excellence. A truly outstanding public school system would not require two out of three community college students to enroll in a remedial English, reading, or mathematics class. Rather, they should graduate high school with the knowledge and skills required to be successful in any post-graduate endeavor they choose.

Appendix. School-Level Graduation Rates and Developmental Course Enrollment

The NC Community College System maintains data that match student enrollment in Developmental courses to their former school.⁹

The following table includes high schools that 1) have three years of both graduation and Developmental course enrollment data available and 2) have not been divided into separate schools-within-a-school any time between 2007 and 2009. Thus, a number of high schools are not included. The table includes only students who have taken a Developmental course the year after their graduation from high school. All Developmental statistics cover the year following the graduation year.¹⁰
