


By The Numbers:

What Government Costs in North Carolina Cities and Counties

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Forward

By the Numbers is the most widely read and requested publication produced by the Center for Local Innovation. This annual publication, researched and written by adjunct policy analyst Michael Lowrey since 1999, has become highly anticipated by elected officials, members of the media, and grassroots activists. Over that period of time, this work has also become a staple for those seeking a quick grasp of the cost of local government almost anywhere in the state of North Carolina. Regardless of one's knowledge about the complexity of local government, a reader can use this report to easily discern a snapshot of city and/or county finances. Moreover, the cumulative body of work since 1999 has shown an alarming trend, as the cost of local government continues to rise faster than population growth and inflation.

Lowrey mines a great deal of data from the State Treasurer's office and painstakingly assembles the information into a succinct, easily understood guide. Local officials, staff, business executives, and informed citizens always glean a great deal of information with respect to their home cities and counties, as well as those comparable cities and counties across the state. This data is also retrospective in that it covers data through the end of reporting for 2005.

It is equally important to note that this guide is *NOT* a judgment as to the efficacy or efficiency of local government. *By the Numbers* is simply a tool that reflects expenditures, taxes collected, incomes, and demographics. It represents unbiased, static data. Having toured dozens of counties across this state with this data, I've found many people who are excited to hear that their county or city ranks low in burdens and others that are greatly disturbed by their relatively high rank. The truth is that citizens and local officials should determine if they are getting what they are paying for and to what extent public services are being performed efficiently.

Furthermore, people should ask challenging questions about what cities or counties should be doing. Senior centers, parks and recreation departments, trash collection, greenways, golf courses and civic centers are a few non-mandated services that account for disparities in costs between areas. Many would argue their necessity as being important as to an area's quality of life; others would say government should focus on more core functions like law enforcement and fire protection. These are the discussions communities should have.

When comparing cities and counties one should also take into account the existing tax base. Many resort and beach areas have high values and relatively few full-time residents. Such a situation can make burdens look artificially high.

Mandates from the state also take a toll on counties across the state. Rural areas often feel this burden far more than urbanized areas. And while debates can be had as to what the state should or should not be doing, it is factually accurate to say that the cost of local government in North Carolina continues to rise faster than population growth and inflation. Incomes rose, which alleviated some of this rise, but it will become necessary at some point to understand that such growth in government is not sustainable. Government cannot continue to take an increasing bite out of personal incomes without becoming more "master" than "servant." Medicaid, transportation, mental health, economic development, and education will continue to dominate political debate for the foreseeable future.

Debating such topics often and openly will be the key to solving these and other challenges. More often than not, debate is limited and poorly covered by local media. With a document like *By the Numbers*, my hope is that such discussions will proliferate and new, innovative ideas will be considered. It will take leadership and vision to move forward on these fronts. Here's hoping hundreds of local debates take place.

Executive Summary

Counties and towns are a critical level of government in North Carolina, providing or administering many critical services while taking in billions of dollars of revenue. This is especially true as the state government has increasingly shifted more taxing authority to localities to make up for money kept by the state. While the importance of county and municipal government is great, obtaining comparative data is difficult. To help address this problem, *By The Numbers* 2007 provides information of how much local government costs in every city and county in North Carolina.

Methodology

Using the most recent data available on property taxes, sales taxes, and miscellaneous taxes and fees from the State Treasurer's Annual Financial Information Report, we calculated county and municipal tax and fee burdens in two ways: 1) as a percentage of income (for counties), and 2) per capita (for counties and municipalities). We then constructed a set of rankings to view the cost of local government more clearly.

Although this analysis is by no means definitive, it gives citizens more useful information for grappling with this complicated issue.

Findings

North Carolina collected over \$17.8 billion in state tax and fee revenues for Fiscal Year 2005 (from July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005), the latest year for which complete data are available. This represented 7.0 percent of the personal income of the state's citizens. In addition, local governments collected an additional \$12.4 billion in property, sales, and other taxes and fees, representing another 4.8 percent of personal income. Combined, they represent a state and local tax and fee burden of 11.8 percent. Federal collections raise the total tax burden on North Carolinians

to approximately 31.2 percent of personal income, on average.

FY 2005, like the year before it, saw an increase in the local tax burden in North Carolina. Local tax and fee collections per capita stood at \$1,1134.68 in the median county, compared to an inflation-adjusted \$1,120.10 the year previous. Though county and municipality revenues rose faster than inflation and property growth, income rose even more, with the local tax and fee burden falling slightly from 2004 (4.66 percent of per-capita personal income) to 2005 (4.55 percent of per-capita personal income).

In FY 2005 the median total property tax burden by county in North Carolina was 2.26 percent of income, or \$563 per person. The range was from \$1,425 per person in Dare County to \$271 per person in Swain County. County rates ranged from 4.54 percent of income in Dare County to 1.20 percent in Alexander County.

It is important to note that incomes vary among counties and within counties over time, and this can affect the rankings. Counties of similar size and tax collections can vary in their burden because of differences in per-capita incomes. Differences among counties can also reflect the rate and extent of annexation, which places more taxpayers onto municipal tax rolls.

Furthermore, data in this report are subject to other reporting issues, which include revisions of percapita personal income estimates and municipalities filing their required reports in an untimely manner. For that reason, the figures for previous years in this edition of *By The Numbers* may not exactly match those reported in previous editions. As such, the current edition's figures take precedence.

Introduction: Local Fiscal Policy a Statewide Issue

The finances of North Carolina's counties and municipalities remain a critical public-policy issue. The state's persistent budgetary difficulties, with never enough money even in the best of years to meaningfully address substantive issues like relieving counties of their debilitating responsibly for partially funding Medicaid, continue to place a heavy burden on local governments, and by extension, local tax-payers. In good years such as FY 2005 with rising per-capita incomes, the growth in local government tax and fee collections is more than absorbed by increases in income.

Calculating burdens

Local governments in North Carolina are required to file audited financial statements with the Department of State Treasurer each year. By The Numbers (BTN) builds upon this information, which is available online at www.nctreasurer.com/DSTHome/StateAndLocalGov/AuditingAndReporting/AFIR.htm.

BTN examines property taxes, sales taxes, and total local government collections of all taxes and fees for counties and municipalities for FY 2005, the latest year for which data is available. For each of the three categories, a revenue per-capita figure was computed. Countywide figures were also calculated as a percentage of per-capita personal income. The specific line-item codes used for each category are listed in Appendix C.

The amount that the average citizen in each North Carolina counties pays for local government, county and municipal, is presented as a dollar amount and a percentage of income on pages 6 though 10.

Appendix A focuses on counties by themselves, including data on property taxes, sales taxes, and total county collections, both per capita and as a percentage of per-capita personal income. Counties are also ranked against each other. Summary data and a list of municipalities in each county can also be found in Appendix A.

Appendix B presents combined town and county tax burdens. Municipalities are sorted by population and ranked in four population ranges (under 1,000; 1,000–4,999; 5,000–24,999; and 25,000 and over).

Appendix B also gives data on property, sales, and total local tax and fee collections.

Readers will immediately notice the relatively high per-capita property taxes in many resort communities in North Carolina. Given the nature of the data, this is not surprising. Second homes and resorts certainly do appear on local tax registers. However, because owners or renters only rarely live in these dwellings year-round, such localities typically have small permanent populations. High tax values divided by a small permanent population will produce a high per-capita tax burden. Therefore, these numbers are not necessarily comparable to other tax-burden statistics.

While *By The Numbers* shows the cost of local government, it does not attempt to measure the quantity or quality of services provided in exchange for those dollars. Nor does the report consider the additional out-of-pocket costs to individuals for services that their local government may not provide. In unincorporated areas, for example, homeowners may have to contract privately for garbage pickup, while those living in a town or city may well receive this service, paid for through their municipal property and other taxes. Municipalities may also use some of their tax dollars to provide a higher quality of fire protection, which may translate into lower homeowners insurance rates.

Importantly, this means that whether a jurisdiction is ranked high or low in cost of government is not the end of the debate over fiscal policy—it is merely the beginning. Citizens of North Carolina's cities and counties must decide whether the services they receive are worth the price they and their fellow residential and business taxpayers are paying in local taxes and fees.

For comparison, we have included a full set of results for counties and rankings for municipalities for FY 2004. To make fair comparisons, figures for earlier fiscal years have been adjusted for inflation. Readers may obtain actual collections in FY 2004 by multiplying the listing by .9710. For FY 2003 partial data, the multiplier is .9488.

Local tax burden up again

In FY 2005, the typical resident of the median county in North Carolina paid \$1,135 in taxes and fees to county and municipal governments. This accounted for 4.55 percent of personal income and a 1.3 percent increase over FY 2004, when collections were an inflation-adjusted \$1,120. Collections in FY 2003 were \$1,055 per capita. Personal income throughout much of North Carolina grew at an even faster rate than local government revenues, so the the burden as a percentage of per-capita personal income was slightly lower in 2005 compared to 2004.

The average North Carolinian, however actually pays more than the typical resident of the median county. Many of the state's larger counties also have above-average local tax and fee burdens; when this is factored in, a state average would amount to 4.83 percent of personal income.

Combined city/county taxes

Dare County residents paid the highest amount in taxes and fees to local government (\$3,750 per capita). The counties of Mecklenburg (\$2,230), Currituck (\$2,167), Brunswick (\$2,081), and Durham (\$2,016) also rank in the top five in revenue collected per capita by county and municipal governments. The results for Dare and Currituck reflect in part their popularity as vacation destinations, with relatively small permanent populations for the property tax base which exists there.

Residents in the counties of Gates (\$688), Hoke (\$693), Alexander (\$708), Caswell (\$710), and Greene (\$764) paid the lowest average amounts in taxes and fees to local governments.

Looking at the local tax burden as a percentage of personal income yielded somewhat different results. Dare County again leads the way with county and municipal revenue accounting for 11.94 percent of per-capita personal income. Second through fifth were the counties of Hyde (8.71 percent of per-capita personal income), Brunswick (8.39 percent), Bladen (7.66 percent), and Currituck (7.64 percent).

By comparison, taxes and fees collected by local

governments accounted for 2.68 percent of per-capita personal income in Alexander County. Second lowest was Gates County at 3.10 percent of per-capita personal income. In eight additional counties, total collections were at 3.5 percent of per-capita personal income or less.

Among the 29 cities with populations over 25,000, Charlotte again had the highest combined city-county tax and fee collections per capita. Wilmington, Asheville, Durham, and Chapel Hill were also in the top five.

Despite still paying the most for local government, Charlotte, and to a lesser degree Wilmington, residents did experience modest reductions in the per capita tax burdens they experienced in fiscal 2005. Property and sales tax collections were essentially flat at the municipal and county level; when combined with population growth, the combined burden in both cities was actually lower in 2005 than in 2004 even before adjusting for inflation.

The lowest per-capita collections were in Jacksonville, followed by Thomasville, Kannapolis, Goldsboro, and Burlington.
